

# Do you live in or travel through North Wakefield?

## *If so, then you WILL BE AFFECTED by the new ONE WAY SYSTEM (URBAN MOTORWAY)*

### The plan includes:

- REDUCING PAVEMENT WIDTH on Bradford and Leeds Roads
- WIDENING Bradford Road to THREE LANES and making it ONE WAY OUT OF TOWN
- WIDENING Leeds Road to THREE LANES and making it ONE WAY INTO TOWN

### How might this affect you?

#### *...Forced into RUSH HOUR TRAFFIC...*

You may have to join heavy traffic travelling the wrong direction to get to where you're going.

#### *...Bus stops FURTHER AWAY...*

Bus users may have to walk further and cross up to 6 lanes of traffic.

#### *...Quiet residential streets become part of an URBAN MOTORWAY...*

Precious conservation areas will become WELL-USED THOROUGHFARES.

#### *...Safety compromised...*

Emergency vehicles will have to take a longer journey through the one-way system in an emergency.
